The Defenders of Wildlife Action Fund's *2007 Conservation Report Card* measures the commitment of U.S. Senators and Representatives to meaningful conservation during the first session of the 110th Congress. It reviews five Senate votes and ten House votes on key conservation issues, providing a clear assessment of how well members of Congress are protecting America's conservation tradition for future generations.

The *2007 Conservation Report Card* covers votes on issues including increasing funding for environmental and conservation programs, charting a new direction in our nation's energy policy, protecting wildlife and habitat in sensitive borderlands and grasslands, and helping wildlife survive global warming.

This report card is an important resource you can use to examine what your elected representatives are doing to conserve our natural heritage for our children and grandchildren. # SENATE

## Key Issues & Votes

### 1 Maintaining the Offshore Drilling Moratorium

The Senate defeated an amendment to an energy bill that would have lifted the offshore drilling moratorium along Virginia's coastline, threatening the entire nationwide offshore drilling moratorium.

*(June 14, 2007, Roll Call No. 212)*

### 2 Setting a New Direction for Energy Policy

The Senate failed to advance a landmark energy bill that would have reduced America's dependence on fossil fuels and increased the use of renewable fuels—a more comprehensive energy bill than the one signed into law later in 2007.

*(December 7, 2007, Roll Call No. 416)*

### 3 Limiting Crop Subsidy Payments to Invest More in Conservation

The Senate failed to adopt an amendment to the Farm Bill that would have limited how much any one farm could collect each year in crop subsidies and used the savings to help fund land conservation and other important efforts.

*(December 13, 2007, Roll Call No. 424)*

### 4 Increasing Funding for Land Conservation Programs

The Senate defeated an amendment to the Farm Bill that would have provided additional funds to conservation programs by redirecting funds made available through responsible reforms in the federal crop insurance program.

*(December 13, 2007, Roll Call No. 428)*

### 5 Upholding the Use of Eminent Domain for Land Protection

The Senate defeated an amendment to the Farm Bill that would have effectively barred federal, state and local governments from using their legal authority to acquire by eminent domain any farmland or grazing land for park, recreation, open space or other conservation purposes.

*(December 13, 2007, Roll Call No. 429)*

# HOUSE

## Key Issues & Votes

### 1 Reducing Big Oil Subsidies and Investing in Clean Energy

The House passed an energy bill that would create a “clean energy fund” by eliminating unnecessary tax subsidies for big oil companies and recovering royalties from offshore oil and gas drilling—a first step toward curbing global warming, a huge threat to wildlife, habitat and human welfare. *(January 18, 2007, Roll Call No. 40)*

### 2 Restoring Environmental Funding

The House passed a budget resolution for 2008 that would make a significant down payment on restoring environmental funding after years of inadequate Bush administration budgets. *(March 29, 2007, Roll Call No. 212)*

### 3 Safeguarding Borderland Habitat and Communities

The House defeated an amendment that would have stripped pro-conservation language from the border security section of the Homeland Security Appropriations Bill. *(June 15, 2007, Roll Call No. 476)*

### 4 Saving the Mexican Wolf Recovery Program

The House defeated an amendment to the Interior Appropriations Bill that would have terminated the landmark Mexican wolf recovery program, which was developed to fulfill the mandate of the Endangered Species Act to save this species from extinction. *(June 26, 2007, Roll Call No. 558)*

### 5 Protecting Habitat in Tongass National Forest

The House passed an amendment to the Interior Appropriations Bill—for the third time in recent years—that would protect important wildlife habitat by stopping taxpayer-subsidized logging road construction in Tongass National Forest, America’s rainforest. *(June 26, 2007, Roll Call No. 563)*

### 6 Saving Polar Bears From Unsustainable Trophy Hunting

The House defeated an amendment to the Interior Appropriations Bill that would have closed a loophole in the Marine Mammal Protection Act that allows American trophy hunters to import polar bear trophies from Canada. *(June 27, 2007, Roll Call No. 573)*

### 7 Restoring Funding for Public Lands and Wildlife

The House passed an Interior Appropriations Bill that would make significant progress in reviving public lands and wildlife programs devastated by years of Bush administration starvation budgets. *(June 27, 2007, Roll Call No. 579)*

### 8 Increasing Grassland Habitat Conservation Funding

The House failed to adopt an amendment to the Farm Bill that would have provided additional funding to help protect important grassland habitats by redirecting funds made available through responsible reforms to the federal crop insurance program. *(July 27, 2007, Roll Call No. 754)*

### 9 Creating a New Energy Direction and Helping Wildlife Survive Global Warming

The House passed an energy and global warming bill that would boost the nation’s energy security by decreasing dependence on fossil fuels and provide a comprehensive framework for reducing the negative impacts of global warming on wildlife and its habitat. *(August 4, 2007, Roll Call No. 832)*

### 10 Setting a New Direction for Energy Policy

The House passed a landmark energy bill that would increase the use of renewable fuels and reduce America’s dependence on fossil fuels—a more comprehensive energy bill than the one that was signed into law later in 2007. *(December 6, 2007, Roll Call No. 1140)*
