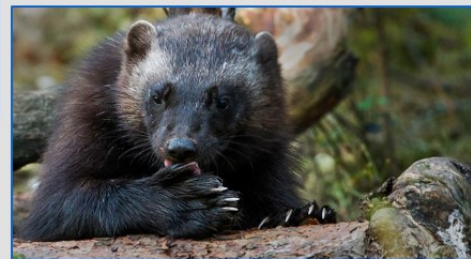


Utah's National Forest Roadless Areas are home to

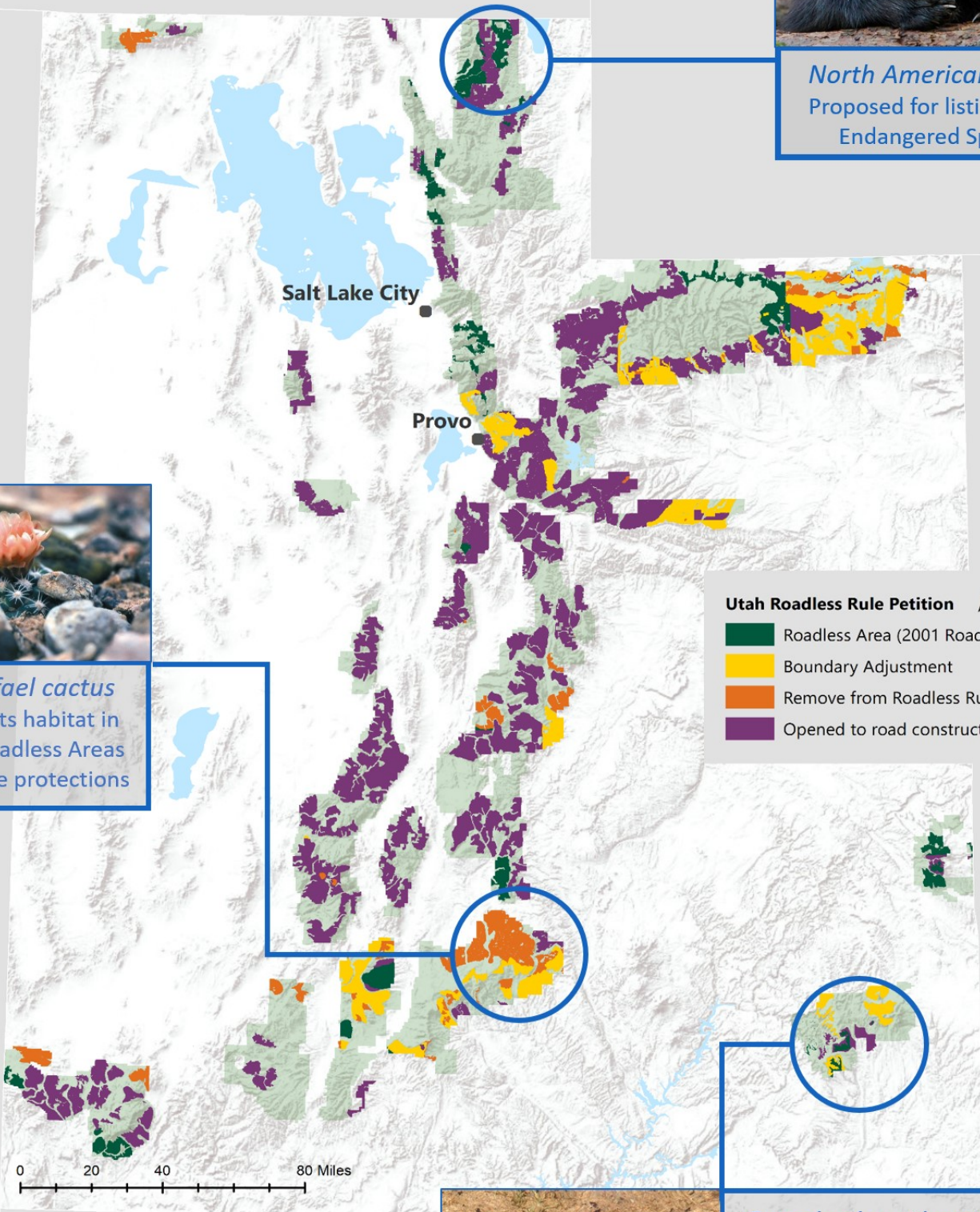
101 at-risk species.

The state of Utah has petitioned to exempt huge swaths of national forests from the Roadless Rule which protects habitats from road construction and logging. Under Utah's proposal, **only 10%** of these public lands would retain protection.

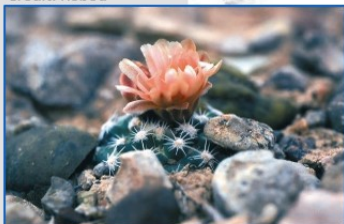
