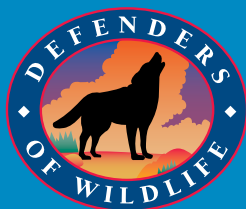

Defenders of Wildlife's *2020 Conservation Report Card* measures the commitment of U.S. senators and representatives to wildlife and habitat conservation during the 2019 and 2020 sessions of the 116th Congress. It tells you at a glance if your elected representatives are preserving America's natural heritage for our children and grandchildren.

This report card reviews 10 Senate votes and 14 House votes with serious implications for wildlife, habitat and the environment, including a 2019 House amendment that would have effectively blocked the development of new conservation measures for the critically imperiled North Atlantic right whale and a 2019 Senate vote to confirm David Bernhardt as Secretary of the Interior. In 2020, votes included one in the House rejecting an amendment that would have eviscerated key marine mammal protections and a pair of Senate votes approving federal judicial nominees with histories of anti-environmental actions. Votes on important conservation measures included a 2019 House bill to restore protections against oil development in Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and a 2020 House measure that included several wildlife protections as part of federal infrastructure legislation. Also in 2020, the House and Senate approved bills, ultimately signed into law, guaranteeing substantial funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

KEY ISSUES & VOTES



1 Blocking Permanent Reauthorization of the Land and Water Conservation Fund

The Senate tabled an amendment that would have reduced permanent reauthorization of the Land and Water Conservation Fund to five years. *(February 7, 2019, Roll Call No. 19)*

2 Undermining the Antiquities Act

The Senate tabled an amendment that would have prohibited the president from designating national monuments in Utah. *(February 7, 2019, Roll Call No. 20)*

3 Confirming Andrew Wheeler as EPA Administrator

The Senate confirmed Deputy EPA Administrator Andrew Wheeler, a former coal-industry lobbyist, as the administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency. *(February 28, 2019, Roll Call No. 33)*

4 Confirming David Bernhardt as Interior Secretary

The Senate confirmed David Bernhardt, a former lobbyist for extractive industries and developers, as secretary of the Department of the Interior. *(April 11, 2019, Roll Call No. 77)*

5 Confirming Susan Combs as an Assistant Interior Secretary

The Senate confirmed Susan Combs, a former Texas state comptroller and outspoken critic of the Endangered Species Act, as the Interior Department's assistant secretary for policy, management and budget. *(June 5, 2019, Roll Call No. 141)*

6 Confirming Aurelia Skipwith as Fish and Wildlife Service Director

The Senate confirmed Aurelia Skipwith, a nominee with ties to interests opposing endangered species protection, as director of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. *(December 12, 2019, Roll Call No. 395)*

7 Confirming Andrew Brasher as a Federal Appeals Court Judge

The Senate confirmed Andrew Brasher, a nominee with a history of opposing keystone environmental laws and civil rights protections, to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. *(February 11, 2020, Roll Call No. 36)*

8 Confirming Joshua Kindred as a Federal District Court Judge

The Senate confirmed Joshua Kindred, a career fossil fuel industry enabler, to be a U.S. District Judge for the District of Alaska. *(February 12, 2020, Roll Call No. 41)*

NOTE: Legislators who served a full term received "Incomplete" scores if they missed more than 25 percent of the key votes. Legislators who served a partial term did not receive "Incomplete" scores unless they missed more than 25 percent of the key votes while they were in office.

9 Removing Obstacles to Guaranteed Funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund

The Senate voted to waive a law and Senate procedural rules that would have blocked a bill to guarantee substantial annual funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund and address the public lands maintenance backlog. (*June 15, 2020, Roll Call No. 118*)

10 Guaranteeing Substantial Funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund

The Senate approved legislation guaranteeing \$900 million per year for the Land and Water Conservation Fund and \$9.5 billion over five years to address the public lands maintenance backlog. (*June 17, 2020, Roll Call No. 121*)

KEY ISSUES & VOTES



- 1 Opposing Damaging Border Wall Funding**

The House passed a short-term funding bill to reopen the Department of Homeland Security, closed due to a government shutdown, without additional funding for the expansion of a proposed wall along the U.S.-Mexico border. The wall would damage sensitive lands and wildlife habitat. *(January 3, 2019, Roll Call No. 9)*
- 2 Blocking Withdrawal from the Paris Climate Change Agreement**

The House passed a bill that would have required the president to adhere to and update the landmark 2015 Paris Agreement on climate change. *(May 2, 2019, Roll Call No. 184)*
- 3 Blocking Conservation Measures for North Atlantic Right Whales**

The House rejected an amendment that would have prohibited the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) from using a science-based, stakeholder-driven decision support tool for conservation and protection of the critically imperiled North Atlantic right whale. The amendment would have effectively blocked vital new right whale protections under development by NMFS. *(June 20, 2019, Roll Call No. 372)*
- 4 Protecting the Tongass—America’s Rainforest**

The House passed an amendment to protect the Tongass National Forest by blocking multimillion-dollar tax subsidies for expensive and destructive road building in this forest with 17 million acres of prime fish and wildlife habitat. *(June 20, 2019, Roll Call No. 382)*

- 5 Funding Wildlife Protections and Rejecting Harmful Riders**

The House passed an FY 2020 Interior appropriations bill that provided significant funding increases for the Endangered Species Act and other crucial wildlife programs, held the Trump administration accountable for drilling in Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, and eliminated a rider blocking protections for the imperiled greater sage-grouse. *(June 25, 2019, Roll Call No. 408)*
- 6 Prohibiting Oil and Gas Leasing off Florida’s Gulf Coast**

The House passed a bill permanently extending a moratorium on oil and gas leasing off the Florida Gulf Coast to reduce threats to marine wildlife. *(September 11, 2019, Roll Call No. 521)*
- 7 Prohibiting Oil and Gas Leasing off the Atlantic and Pacific Coasts**

The House passed a bill prohibiting the Interior Department from conducting oil and gas leasing in the outer continental shelf off the Atlantic and Pacific coasts, preventing activities that could threaten marine wildlife. *(September 11, 2019, Roll Call No. 525)*

8 Restoring Protections Against Oil Development in Arctic National Wildlife Refuge

The House passed legislation to stop the government from opening Arctic National Wildlife Refuge to Big Oil by repealing the controversial arctic lease sale provision of the 2017 tax bill. *(September 12, 2019, Roll Call No. 530)*

9 Eviscerating Key Marine Mammal Protections

The House rejected an amendment that would have gutted key provisions of the Marine Mammal Protection Act to fast-track seismic airgun blasting and other industrial activities in the ocean that harm marine mammals. It would also have created dangerous loopholes in Endangered Species Act protections for marine mammals. *(December 10, 2019, Roll Call No. 666)*

10 Protecting Additional Wildlands

The House passed a bill that would protect millions of acres of public lands as Wilderness, Wild & Scenic Rivers, and other areas of conservation importance. *(February 12, 2020, Roll Call No. 69)*

11 Strengthening Wildlife Protections Through National Infrastructure Improvement

The House passed a broad infrastructure package to create a national system of wildlife corridors, restore legacy roads and trails, create a national wildlife refuge, and fund aquatic resilience. *(July 1, 2020, Roll Call No. 138)*

12 Guaranteeing Substantial Funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund

The House approved legislation guaranteeing \$900 million per year for the Land and Water Conservation Fund and \$9.5 billion over five years to address the public lands maintenance backlog. *(July 22, 2020, Roll Call No. 155)*

13 Funding Wildlife Protections and Rejecting Harmful Riders

The House passed a four-bill FY 2021 appropriations package, including Interior and Environment and Agriculture appropriations, that provides funding increases for the Endangered Species Act and other crucial wildlife programs and eliminates a rider that prevents protections for the imperiled greater sage-grouse. *(July 24, 2020, Roll Call No. 166)*

14 Funding Wildlife Protections for Marine and Coastal Species

The House passed a six-bill FY 2021 appropriations package including the Commerce Justice Science bill, which provides funding for conservation of marine and coastal species, including a needed increase for the critically endangered North Atlantic right whale. *(July 31, 2020, Roll Call No. 178)*
