- 1. Brown paper bag cut flat before the class
- 2. Water container (fill before class starts)
- 3. Towel (paper or rags)
- 4. Paint pallet (paper plate or scrap cardboard)
- 5. Canvas (16x20)
- 6. Xlarge paint brush- (2 1/2 ish flat)
- 7. Large- (1 to 1 1/2ish flat)
- 8. Medium less than an inch (3/4 flat)
- 9. Small -about the size of pencil (#5 round)
- 10. Tiny -fine detail brush (script brush #1)
- 11.Q-tips at least 2-3
- 12. Painter's tape
- 13. Hair blow dryer (or fan)
- 14.Old toothbrush (the stiffer the better)
- 15. Colors needed: White, black, brown, blue, turquoise, green, yellow, purple, and red
