Defenders of Wildlife's *2023 Conservation Report Card* measures the commitment of U.S. senators and representatives to wildlife and habitat conservation during the 1st session of the 118th Congress. It tells you at a glance whether your elected representatives are preserving America's natural heritage for our children and grandchildren in the various votes they are casting.

This report card reviews seven House votes and four Senate votes with serious implications for wildlife, habitat and the environment. In 2023, the House and Senate approved resolutions under the Congressional Review Act (CRA) that would have revoked recent actions by U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to establish new Endangered Species Act (ESA) protections for imperiled species including the lesser prairie chicken and the northern long-eared bat. While Congress narrowly approved these measures, they were subsequently vetoed by President Biden and did not become law. Both houses also approved CRA resolutions weakening Clean Water Act protections for wetlands and waterways. As in the case of the ESA resolutions, these measures did not become law due to a presidential veto.

Other House votes include the passage of an amendment to the FY24 Interior appropriations bill blocking draft rules to strengthen ESA implementation and passage of the Interior funding bill itself. The Interior bill that included 15 provisions undermining the ESA as well as funding cuts undermining the program's implementation. Senate votes also included the approval of a Congressional Review Act resolution revoking a stronger endangered species habitat regulation.

KEY ISSUES & VOTES

1 WEAKENING PROTECTIONS FOR WETLANDS AND WATERWAYS

The Senate passed a resolution that would have weakened Clean Water Act protections for wetlands and waterways by revoking a revised regulatory definition of “Waters of the United States.” (*March 29, 2023, Roll Call No. 79*)

2 REVOKING PROTECTIONS FOR THE IMPERILED LESSER PRAIRIE CHICKEN


The Senate passed a resolution that would have revoked the Endangered Species Act listings of two populations of the lesser prairie chicken as threatened and endangered, respectively. (*May 3, 2023, Roll Call No. 110*)

3 REVOKING A STRONGER ENDANGERED SPECIES HABITAT REGULATION

The Senate passed a resolution that would have revoked a joint National Marine Fisheries Service and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service revised definition of “habitat” under the Endangered Species Act. (*May 11, 2023, Roll Call No. 122*)

4 REVOKING PROTECTIONS FOR THE IMPERILED NORTHERN LONG EARED BAT

The Senate passed a resolution that would have revoked stronger protections for the northern long-eared bat stemming from a rule reclassifying its status from threatened to endangered under the Endangered Species Act. (*May 11, 2023, Roll Call No. 123*)

1 WEAKENING PROTECTIONS FOR WETLANDS AND WATERWAYS

The House passed a resolution that would have weakened Clean Water Act protections for wetlands and waterways by revoking a revised regulatory definition of “Waters of the United States.” (*March 9, 2023, Roll Call No. 142*)

2 EXPANDING FOSSIL FUEL DEVELOPMENT AND OVERRIDING BEDROCK LAWS

The House passed a bill to mandate expanded fossil fuel development and override laws including the National Environmental Policy Act, threatening important habitats, the critically imperiled Rice’s whale and many additional endangered species as well impacted communities. (*March 30, 2023, Roll Call No. 182*)

3 EXEMPTING THE MILITARY FROM COMPLYING WITH THE ESA

The House rejected an amendment that would have exempted U.S. military from complying with the Endangered Species Act. (*July 13, 2023, Roll Call No. 322*)

4 REVOKING PROTECTIONS FOR THE IMPERILED LESSER PRAIRIE CHICKEN

The House passed a resolution that would have revoked the Endangered Species Act listings of two populations of the lesser prairie chicken as threatened and endangered, respectively. (*July 27, 2023, Roll Call No. 381*)

The House passed a resolution that would have revoked stronger protections for the northern long-eared bat stemming from a rule reclassifying its status from threatened to endangered under the Endangered Species Act. (*July 27, 2023, Roll Call No. 382*)

6 BLOCKING DRAFT RULES TO STRENGTHEN ENDANGRED SPECIES ACT IMPLEMENTATION

The House passed an amendment to prohibit FWS from completing a rulemaking process to strengthen implementation of the Endangered Species Act. (*November 2, 2023, Roll Call No. 575*)

7 UNDERMINING PROTECTIONS AND FUNDING FOR ENDANGERED SPECIES

The House passed an appropriations bill with 15 provisions undermining the Endangered Species Act and other environmental protections and cutting funding for endangered species, national wildlife refuges and other public lands, clean water, clean air, climate change and many other vital environmental programs. (*November 3, 2023, Roll Call No. 597*)
