14	production of oil or natural gas in any area of the outer
15	Continental Shelf located in the Washington/Oregon Plan-
16	ning Area, the Northern California Planning Area, the
17	Central California Planning Area, or the Southern Cali-
18	fornia Planning Area, as such planning areas are depicted
19	in the 2024–2029 National Outer Continental Shelf Oil
20	and Gas Leasing Proposed Final Program (September
21	2023).".
