




IDAHO'S WAR ON WOLVES

Since Idaho took over management of its wolves in 2009, the state's wolf population has declined 23%.

Idaho has gunned-down wolves from helicopters, hired professional gunmen to kill entire packs in wilderness areas, and drastically weakened hunting and trapping regulations.


Idaho's Methods of Wolf Killing Since 2009

But Idaho's war on wolves has just begun...

Governor Otter recently green-lighted the use of \$400,000 in taxpayer funds annually for five years to drive Idaho's wolf population down as low as 150 animals.
